

March 1st Bus Trip Itinerary Details

1. Start at Township Complex
2. Take Old Philadelphia Pike to Black River Road to Route 378 south
3. Left turn on Colesville Road. Turn into bank parking lot (**Stop #1**)
4. Go north on Route 378 to Saucon Square Shopping Center (**Stop #2**)
5. North on 378 to Mountain Drive North and immediate left into Joe Topper's office building parking lot (**Stop#3**)
6. Pull out of parking lot and go left up Mountain Drive North. Bear right at fork and continue right past Ben Franklin Technology Center and down Mountain Drive South
7. Turn left at Broadhead Court and turn around in cul-de-sac
8. Back on to Mountain Drive and proceed down and turn left into Goodman Drive. Take Goodman Drive to Creek Road to Friedensville Road.
9. Right turn on Friedensville Road past Society Hill and Bagel Basket shopping center
10. Left turn onto Meadows Road. Turn right at Fox Run and left onto O'Brien's Court to stop sign at Meadows (**Stop #4**) to point out Heritage tract
11. Take Meadows down Skibo to Walnut Street in Hellertown. Turn right onto Route 412 south.
12. Take 412 south to Giant shopping Center (**Stop #5**)
13. Take 412 south to Bechdolt's Orchards and turn around in Courtney Court cul-de-sac in Orchard View subdivision (**Stop #6**)
14. Take 412 north to Polk Valley Road to Saucon Valley School District on Polk Valley Road (**Stop #7**) – **BATHROOM BREAK**
15. Take Polk Valley Road around to Reservoir Road past Silver Creek Golf Course.
16. Take Wassergass to old elementary school (**Stop #8**)
17. Take Wassergass to Wilhelm and then down Apple Street to Easton Road.
18. Take Easton Road out to Ringhoffer Road. (**Stop #9**) along Easton Road
19. Take Ringhoffer Road to Applebutter Road. Applebutter Road past landfill out to Shimersville Road. Pull off just below landfill (**Stop #10**)
20. Left on Shimersville down to 412 to Commerce Center Boulevard. Travel to end of boulevard and turn around at Majestic Center.
21. Head back to Township building via Silvex Road to College Drive to Seidersville Road.
