**ORDINANCE NO. 2009-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER SAUCON, COUNTY OF NORTHAMPTON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING AND REVISING CHAPTER 170, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER SAUCON TO PROVIDE FOR THE REDUCTION OF SPEED LIMIT ON A PORTION OF APPLE STREET.**

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower Saucon, a Township of the Second Class, Optional Plan, has adopted Chapter 170 of the Code of Lower Saucon Township (hereinafter "Code") relating to vehicles and traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower Saucon desires to amend Chapter 170, Vehicles and Traffic, at §170-20 of the Code for the purpose of reducing the speed limit on Apple Street between the Hellertown Borough line and Wilhelm Drive, from 35 mph to 25 mph within Lower Saucon Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township has complied with all applicable pre-requisites and/or requirements under the law with regard to this speed limit reduction; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this Ordinance shall promote the health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the citizens of Lower Saucon Township.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE Council of the Township of Lower Saucon, County of Northampton, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows:

**SECTION 1**

The foregoing Whereas clauses are incorporated herein the same as if set forth herein again at length.

**SECTION 2**

Chapter 170, Vehicles and Traffic, at §170-20 of the Code of the Township of Lower Saucon regarding Speed Limits is hereby amended to revise the following information:

Chapter 170-20 Speed Limits

A. The following speed limit is hereby established:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Speed Limit (miles per hour)</u>
Apple Street (T395) (between Hellertown Borough line and Wilhelm Drive)	Entire length	25

**SECTION 3**

Severability – The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause, or Section of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid; such Decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as a legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional illegal or invalid provision not been included herein.

**SECTION 4**

Repealer – All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5**

Effective Date – This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption thereof.
