ORDINANCE NO. 2009-05

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER SAUCON,
NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE
NOS. 91-5, 84-5, AND 78-6 IN THEIR ENTIRETY**

WHEREAS, Lower Saucon Township is a Township of the Second Class, Optional Plan, located in Northampton County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower Saucon previously adopted Ordinances 91-5, 84-5, and 78-6 pertaining to accessibility to certain lots of land, and the issuance of building permits for said lots and other structures within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Lower Saucon Township subsequently adopted the Code of the Township of Lower Saucon, which regulates the subject matter contained in Ordinances 91-5, 84-5, and 78-6; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Lower Saucon Township desires to repeal the three Ordinances referred to herein in their entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Township of Lower Saucon, Northampton County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that Ordinances 91-5, adopted on September 18, 1991, 84-5, adopted on June 6, 1984, and 78-6, adopted on October 18, 1978, are hereby repealed in their entirety. The subject matter contained therein shall be regulated by the provisions of the Code of the Township of Lower Saucon as adopted, and amended.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after adoption.
