ORDINANCE No. 2016-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER SAUCON, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING AND REVISING CHAPTER 170, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER SAUCON, SECTION 170 – 23 (STOP INTERSECTIONS) BY REMOVING THE EXISTING STOP SIGN LOCATED ON NORTH DRIVE (NORTHBOUND) AND ADDING A NEW STOP SIGN LOCATED ON WOODLAND DRIVE (EASTBOUND)

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower Saucon previously adopted Ordinance 98–17, The Code of the Township of Lower Saucon, on May 20, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Lower Saucon Township now desires to amend Chapter 170 (Vehicles and Traffic) Section 170-23(A) of said Code to remove the existing stop sign located on North Drive (northbound), and adding a new stop sign located on Woodland Drive (eastbound), as recommended by an Engineering Traffic Study performed by the Township Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Lower Saucon Township has determined that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Lower Saucon Township.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Lower Saucon Township Council as follows:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF WHEREAS CLAUSES.

The WHEREAS clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth at length.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 170-23, “STOP INTERSECTIONS” SUBSECTION A.

- a. Section 170-23(A), Individual Township roads, of the Code of the Township of Lower Saucon is hereby amended by deleting the following line:

North Drive (T446) Woodland Drive (T447) North

- b. Section 170-23(A), Individual Township roads, of the Code of the Township of Lower Saucon is hereby amended by adding the following line:

Woodland Drive (T447) North Drive (T446) East

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of Lower Saucon Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such stricken provision not been included herein.

SECTION 4. REPEALER

All other Ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions hereof, are repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its enactment.
