RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SUBMISSION OF GRANT APPLICATION BY THE LOWER SAUCON TOWNSHIP HISTORICAL SOCIETY FOR REPOINTING OF THE LUTZ-FRANKLIN SCHOOLHOUSE

WHEREAS, the Lower Saucon Township desires to preserve the integrity of its historic structures located within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Lutz-Franklin Schoolhouse was placed on the National Register of Historic Places by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission (PHMC) on December 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Lower Saucon Township Historical Society (LSTHS) has been a steward in renovating and maintaining the Schoolhouse; and

WHEREAS, the LST Historical Society has raised funds and obtained quotes for the repointing of the stonework on the Lutz-Franklin Schoolhouse; and

WHEREAS, the LST Historical Society wishes to obtain funding to defray expenses necessary for the repair to the stonework on the Schoolhouse; and

WHEREAS, the LST Historical Society will be submitting a matching grant application to the Pennsylvania Historic and Museum Commission in the amount of \$20,900.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Council of Lower Saucon Township supports the Lower Saucon Township Historical Society in their endeavor to obtain funding from the Pennsylvania Historic and Museum Commission and approves the submission of a grant in the amount of \$20,900.00.
2. That should the cost of the project exceed \$43,000.00 the Lower Saucon Township Council, as the owner of the Lutz-Franklin Schoolhouse, approves contributing an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00.
