### A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE

### LOWER SAUCON UCC & RED DOOR

### FOR THEIR PARTICIPATION IN THE ADOPT-A-ROAD PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, the Lower Saucon Township Adopt-a-Road Program was established in 2010 following a request from the Lower Saucon Sportsmen's Association to adopt the Township portion of Ringhoffer Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the organizations and families who adopt one of the twenty-three (23) Township road sections selected for the program are provided with a safety orientation and equipment, and are asked to conduct twice-a-year litter clean-ups along their adopted roads; and

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of these efforts, the Township erects permanent signs along their road with the group's name; and

**WHEREAS**, Lower Saucon UCC & Red Door volunteered in 2010 to adopt Bergstresser Drive and since then have devoted 9 hours of volunteer time keeping Bergstresser Drive clean and litter free; and

**WHEREAS**, through the efforts of this group of volunteers who have devoted over 389 hours conducting these clean-ups, over 718 bags of trash, 81 tires, 10 pieces of furniture, and other assorted car parts and electronics have been removed from Township roadsides; and

**WHEREAS**, Lower Saucon Township would like to recognize and commend Lower Saucon UCC & Red Door for their efforts in helping to keep our Township roads clean and attractive.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Council of Lower Saucon Township, Ronald Horiszny, President; Thomas Maxfield, Vice President; Priscilla deLeon, Council Member; Glenn Kern, Council Member; and David Willard, Council Member; wishes to thank Lower Saucon UCC & Red Door for their hard work and dedication to Lower Saucon Township.
