A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE

ST. THERESA'S SCHOOL

FOR THEIR PARTICIPATION IN THE ADOPT-A-ROAD PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Lower Saucon Township Adopt-a-Road Program was established in 2010 following a request from the Lower Saucon Sportsmen's Association to adopt the Township portion of Ringhoffer Road; and

WHEREAS, the organizations and families who adopt one of the twenty-three (23) Township road sections selected for the program are provided with a safety orientation and equipment, and are asked to conduct twice-a-year litter clean-ups along their adopted roads; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of these efforts, the Township erects permanent signs along their road with the group's name; and

WHEREAS, St. Theresa's School volunteered in 2012 to adopt Meadows Road and since then have devoted 8 hours of volunteer time keeping Meadows Road clean and litter free; and

WHEREAS, through the efforts of this group of volunteers who have devoted over 389 hours conducting these clean-ups, over 718 bags of trash, 81 tires, 10 pieces of furniture, and other assorted car parts and electronics have been removed from Township roadsides; and

WHEREAS, Lower Saucon Township would like to recognize and commend St. Theresa's School for their efforts in helping to keep our Township roads clean and attractive.
